


There's a Reason it's Called the Magic City.



It's All Happening Here.

It's not just about what's inside The Shops of Grand River. It's also about what's all around us at Exit 140 in Leeds. Our property is centrally located within the 6,500-acre planned community of Grand River, which has become a high-growth area along the I-20 corridor between Birmingham and Atlanta. Our stores are anchored at Exit 140, which features the popular destinations listed at right with more developments on the way. Each year, over 8.2 million people come to Grand River to visit The Shops, Bass Pro, Buc-ee's, and Barber Motorsports Park, and attend events such as the Children's of Alabama Indy Grand Prix.







Area Attractions

Buc-ee's

If you've never been to Buc-ee's, buckle up. The legendary convenience store chain prides itself on setting records—like the world's largest convenience store, the world's longest carwash, and the world's cleanest restrooms.

Barber Motorsports Park

One of the world's premier racing circuits, Barber Motorsports Park is home to the Children's Indy Grand Prix of Alabama, and the largest Porsche driving experience in the world. Located 5 minutes from The Shops of Grand River, the 880-acre, multi-purpose racing facility also includes the Barber Vintage Motorsports Museum, which boasts the largest collection of motorcycles in the world. For race fans, **Talladega Superspeedway**, the Harley Davidson U.S. Test Facility, and the International Motorsports Hall of Fame are all less than a 35-minute drive.

Bass Pro Shops Outdoor World

Bass Pro Shops Outdoor World, located on the south side of the I-20 interchange across from The Shops of Grand River, is the world's leading supplier of outdoor products; it is part museum, art gallery, education, conservation, and entertainment center.

In addition to the world-class attractions at Grand River, there is \$175M in planned development on land surrounding the center over the next few years.



The Grand River Parkway Bridge

A new connection to our neighbors to the north will bring more guests to The Shops of Grand River. Located north of the shopping center on Grand River Parkway, the \$15M Grand River Parkway Bridge will span the Cahaba River, connecting the 3,000 acres to the north, which includes the new Alabama Dreams Park and a 500-acre residential community with over 900 new homes.

Alabama Dreams Park

An all-new, 275-acre sports complex is coming to Grand River soon, and will serve as a hub for tournaments, including soccer, lacrosse, baseball, softball, track & field, volleyball, and more. More families in the area means more visitors to The Shops of Grand River—making this development a home run. The sports park is projected to open in spring 2027.

The Shops of Grand River-Expanded Hospitality and Entertainment

A new 175-room, full-service hotel with a restaurant, outdoor amenities, and an event plaza is being developed at the north end of the center. Plans include a 3,000-seat amphitheater accommodating popular sports like pickleball and volleyball. On the 14 acres bordering the Cahaba River, plans include walking trails and a launching area for canoes and kayaks.





West Tract Lagoon and Hotel

On 60 acres directly west of The Shops, plans include a major multi-acre lagoon project with a hotel and restaurants.

Grand River North Residential Community

This new, master-planned residential community will be located directly north of The Shops of Grand River, surrounding the Alabama Dreams Park. The initial plan includes 533 acres and 991 single-family homes.
